

BNSW State League Appeal Procedure

In the event that a club wishes to appeal a penalty handed down by the League, they are to follow the procedures indicated below as per **Rule 22.11** of the BNSW State League Playing Rules, Policies & Procedures document.

Rule 22.11

Clubs have the right to appeal any decision of the SLSC to the SLSC Appeals Committee. Any Club wishing to appeal to the SLSC Appeal Committee shall forward to the Competition Manager a clear statement of the grounds for the appeal. The appeal, along with the \$100 lodgement fee, shall be received with three (3) days of the SLSC's original decision. The \$100 will be forfeited should the appeal be dismissed.

Failure to observe the CORRECT PROCEDURE shall render the protest invalid.
