

2020 NSW Metro Youth Women's Trial Information

Baseball NSW is pleased to announce that registrations are open for the NSW Metro Youth Women's State Representative Team Trials to compete in the 2020 Womens National Championship.

Baseball Australia has yet to announce a venue, date or format for the National Championships for 2020 but historically it has been held in April of each year across a 7-8-day event. Once information comes to hand, we will be sure to inform all players whom register. The approximate cost per player historically has been in the \$3000 - \$3500 range.

To be eligible to trial for this age category, players must meet the following criteria:

"Competing players must be at least 12 years of age prior to the commencement of the Championship but not have turned 16 years of age as of 31st December of the preceding year (2019). Example: Under 16 player who turns 16 on 31st December 2019 is not eligible, whereas a player who turns 16 on 1st January 2020 is eligible for the Under 16 NYWC."

If you are unable to attend the trials due to extenuating circumstances, you will need to apply for an exemption in writing as per the Selection Policy. This should be directed to the BNSW State baseball Operations Manager on the e-mail address provided below.

The trials will be conducted at the following venues on the following dates:

- Monday 14 Oct 2019 (Field 2 @ BISP from 6:30-9:00pm) – Data Collation (Part A)
- Wednesday 16 Oct 2019 (Field 3 @ BISP from 6:30-9:00pm) – Skills Assessment (Pitching/Defence)
- Monday 21 Oct 2019 (Field 2 @ BISP from 6:30-9:00pm) – Skills Assessment (Offensive Assessments)
- Wednesday 23 Oct 2019 (Field 3 @ BISP from 6:30-9:00pm) – Skills Assessment (2nd Position)
- Monday 28 Oct 2019 (Field 2 @ BISP from 6:30-9:00pm) – Game Simulation (Part B)
- Wednesday 30 Oct 2019 (Laybutt Reserve, Blacktown from 6:30-9:00pm) – Game Simulation (Part B)

Players will need to wear full baseball uniform (*former state representation apparel will not be allowed*) and provide their own equipment to take part in the trials.

Please be aware that players who are deemed unsuccessful by Team Coaching Staff in conjunction with BNSW High Performance Staff maybe cut after PART A of the selection process which concludes after the trial conducted on Wednesday 23 October 2019

BNSW anticipates the team will be finalised by the November 1st, 2019.

This may be delayed if the trial schedule is affected by wet weather/cancellations.

Please note: Successful players will be expected to make themselves available for 2 or 3 practice sessions per week until the beginning of the AWC as well as any practice games as organised by team coaching staff.
