



Baseball NSW 2022 Sydney Cup This October

The Baseball NSW Sydney Cup is fast approaching, and we're excited to begin the competition in October.

Following the success of the 2021 Sydney Cup, this year's season will once again be a great opportunity for players across the metropolitan and surrounding Sydney area associations to enjoy higher levels of competition. Aimed at our U/12, U/14, and U/16 players, the three tournaments have been named in honour of influential families, Worboys, Balfour, and Shipley, all of whom have had significant roles in shaping Baseball in NSW. The positive opportunities from last year's event will hopefully encourage more of the same this year with memorable experiences among the teams travelling and hosting at various associations. Access to ABL games in both Sydney and Canberra will again be available where players and parents can socialise and expand their friendships.

The round-robin tournament will begin after the October long weekend and will run from October 9th through to December 18th.



The tournaments will consist of seven (7) teams per division. The participating associations include Hills, Cronulla, Ryde, Greater Western, Macarthur, Manly, and a team representing Baseball ACT.

To make things more interesting this year, the champion teams from each division will be given the opportunity to travel to Cooperstown, New York to attend the "Cooperstown Baseball World Tournament" and represent Baseball NSW during the 2023 July School holidays.

Barclay Cup Tournament 2022 Announcement

Thank you to all the players who expressed interest and attended trials for the Barclay Cup this month. Due to the great response to the event, Baseball NSW is likely to be able to send two teams comprising of a squad of 12-14 players each.

What you need to know:

The tournament is named in honour of Jacinda Barclay, who had a major impact on Women's Baseball in Australia. Jacinda was a National representative Baseball player, playing professionally in three different sports over her career.



As a pioneer in women's sports, this event is aptly named to recognise the impression she has left.

Are you interested in obtaining your Baseball Coaches Accreditation?





CLAIM TWO \$100 ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHERS

All NSW school-enrolled children are eligible for **two \$100 Active Kids vouchers** each year. The vouchers can be used with any approved Active Kids provider, to help cover costs towards registration or membership fees for sport and active recreation. **Voucher one is valid January to December** and **voucher two is valid July to December**. After 1 July 2020, the second voucher can be claimed immediately after the first voucher.



How to guide for Schools

Sporting Schools is a \$100 million Australian Government initiative designed to help schools increase children's participation in sport and to connect children with community sport. The Australian Sports Commission (ASC) has partnered with more than 30 national sporting organisations (NSOs) to extend the delivery of the program across Australia via their networks of aligned organisations and coaches, ensuring a consistent and quality experience for all.
