



2024 Women's World Cup Tournament

Off the back of our Australian Women's Championships and a successful Youth Womens Championships in Victoria, we share with you Australia's pathway in the 2024 Women's World Cup of Baseball.

Baseball Australia have reported that Australia will be one of six teams placed in Group A with Canada, USA, Mexico and two qualifiers coming from the upcoming Asian Women's Baseball Championship. The Emeralds will battle the competition in Group A action in Thunder Bay, Canada in August 2023. Group B will take part in Japan in September.

Unlike other years and editions of the World Cup, this competition will take place over two years.

The Top Two teams from each group, plus two wild cards, will advance to the final group stage in August 2024 where the competition will return to Thunder Bay to determine the World Champion.

The 2024 tournament will be the ninth edition of the Women's Baseball World Cup. Australia has traditionally fared well at the World Cup. They've finished in the Top 4 on six occasions with their best result being a silver medal in 2010.

NSW Youth Women's Team Secure Silver at Nationals

Congratulations to our NSW Youth team who have finished second at the Australian Women's Youth Championships!

A hard fought game against Queensland on Wednesday afternoon saw them come away with silver at this years Youth Women's Nationals, which is no easy feat. The team really stepped up to the challenge in their round games to make the gold medal match! Going 1-2 in their first two days of the tournament, these losses meant they had to win their last two games to be in with a chance.

On Tuesday afternoon, NSW Youth came up against Western Australia and secured the win 7-3! A seven run rally in the bottom of the third was kickstarted by Mariam Arifaki. In this game we saw another solid outing from Brydi Peppard going 2IP, 2ER, and 4SO.

Following this, the team went on to defeat Victoria 12-7. Some stand out performances from Eden Neave, who went 2/3 with 2 RBI and Lily McKenner also had 2 RBI.

The competition ran alongside the Australian Women's Championships which saw the top opens women's baseball players across the country compete. This year we had the pleasure of sending two NSW teams away! In interviews with Baseball Australia, NSW player Claire O'Sullivan mentioned "the girls learned a lot this week and we really enjoyed ourselves." Our NSW Composite Team Head Coach, Chantelle Cornick, spoke to BA saying "The fact that we're here, we've got this team together... getting this experience under their belt... it's been a win-win regardless of the results."

Baseball Australia awarded Spirit of the Game Awards in both competitions. Congratulations to recipients Alyssa Frame (NSW Youth), Sayaka Mori (NSW Opens) and Beatrix Cobon (NSW Composite Opens). The award is



given to a player from each team who displays the values and attributes of fair play, teamwork, community and team respect. Well done ladies!

Congratulations to all who attended the Womens Nationals events! Baseball NSW appreciate your time and effort dedicated to continuing to grow the Women's game and we're excited to see what the future holds.

After 1 July 2020, the second voucher can be claimed immediately after the first voucher.
