
# Vale Peter Street Beloved Member of the Community

# Club Corner cont. Castle Hill Baseball's Winter Development Programs




### Jaylin Rae Plunders Awards, Buccaneers Celebrate

Jaylin Rae has had an unreal season for the CSU Buccaneers. This month, Rae was named to the Big South All-Conference Honorable Mention Team.

Jaylin was also the offensive leader for the Buccaneers this season, hitting .357 in 47 games and flashed power with 12 XBHs while also scoring 36 runs. He sported an OPS of .911 while also slugging .462.

These numbers were a huge contributor to Jaylin being awarded MVP and Best Hitter by CSU Bucs Baseball this season. A solid performance from one of our past BNSW juniors. We're super excited to continue following Jaylin's journey!






### Travis Bazzana: Australian Dynamo Lights Up Oregon State

"An Australian name to keep an eye on!" is a direct quote from Team Australia Baseball and we couldn't agree more. Bazzana has put together one of the greatest regular seasons in Oregon State history in 2023.

The Baseball NSW junior has made an impact at Oregan State University with the Beavers, leading the Pac-12 in stolen bases (with a school single-season record 36), runs scored (74, second all-time to Cole Gillespie's 83), walks (56, second all-time to Adley Rutschman's 76) and onbase percentage (.509) and is tied for the league lead in hits (79). Bazzana ranks fifth in batting average (.376) and also has 19 doubles, 10 home runs, 52 RBIs and 134 total bases in 55 games.

All these stats have greatly contributed to Bazzana's naming in the All-Pac-12 First Team and Pac-12 All Defensive team. An explosive player who continues to light up our screens. We are excited to see everything Trav has in store in his future.

### NSW Reign Champions of 2023 All Schools Competition

## This month, the 33rd Annual School Sport Australia (U18) Baseball Championship was held in Lismore for a week.

The tournament is a contest between the top talent across Australian schools. Teams are pre-selected from school competitions in each of the states, and they come together to compete for the All Schools Championship title. This year, NSW competed for seven wins, with one loss and one draw.

The team then went on to reclaim the championship title from QLD with a 6-4 win in the gold medal match.

Going into the grand final, the reigning title holders Queensland, had beaten NSW in one game (5-2) and drawn the other (7-7). The grand final game was a fiercely contested battle, with Queensland creating an early two run lead. The strong lineup of NSW batters quickly took back the lead in the bottom of the second, from which Queensland chased for the remainder of the game. NSW pitcher, Jackson Frame, kept the Queensland

batters under control for seven innings and was named MVP of the game by the opposing team.

Congratulations to the following players who received awards for their efforts during the event. Luke Donaghey was named MVP of the tournament. Hayden Purchase won the batting award with four NSW players hitting above .500 for the tournament.

As part of the tournament, a twelve player All Australian squad is selected and this year six positions were awarded to NSW players.

## Tamworth Baseball Carnival Coming Soon


Each year on the June long weekend, Tamworth Baseball Association host one of the biggest events on the calendar.

## Are you interested in obtaining your Baseball Coaches Accreditation?

Baseball NSW offers an online coaching accreditation program through the Canopi platform. It aligns BNSW practices with the Baseball Australia revisions for coach accreditations. There are 3 levels (A, B and C) that are recognised nationally. As such, we have updated our coach accreditation requirements, with the USA Baseball Certification being a mandatory component of the BNSW accreditation.

Anyone interested in partaking in our courses can now access everything through the 'Education' section of our updated BNSW website. The online courses allow those interested in acquiring accreditation to do so during the times that work best for them.

All NSW school-enrolled children are eligible for **two \$100 Active Kids vouchers** each year. The vouchers can be used with any approved Active Kids provider, to help cover costs towards registration or membership fees for sport and active recreation. **Voucher one is valid January to December** and **voucher two is valid July to December**. After 1 July 2020, the second voucher can be claimed immediately after the first voucher.
