




Australia To The World 2023 WBSC Women's Baseball World Cup

The Emeralds hit .276 as a team, garnering 42 hits, and scored an average of just over 7 runs per game. New South Wales' own Ticara Geldenhuis blasted one of just 9 home runs hit cumulatively during the tournament, and the only one for Australia, in their 10-3 victory over Korea. The squad closed out the World Cup in Thunder Bay, Canada with a decisive 9-2 win over Hong Kong, bumping the Emeralds up to finish 4th overall.

It was an amazing World Cup campaign from this Women's Squad and we're very proud to have had such great NSW representation on the team. We hope you have all made memories to last a lifetime!


2023-24 State and Women's League Season, Around the Corner

2023 Sydney Cup Scheduled for September!

The Baseball NSW Sydney Cup is just around the corner and is scheduled to begin in September of this year.

The Sydney Cup provides greater opportunities for players across the metropolitan and surrounding Sydney Associations to enjoy higher levels of competition. Aimed at our U/12, U/14, and U/16 players, the three age groups are derived from highly influential baseball legends, Worboys, Balfour, and Shipley, all of whom have had significant roles in shaping Baseball in NSW.

The round-robin tournament will begin on Sunday, September 10th and will run through to mid-December. It is played on a fortnightly basis in conjunction with the associations' regular season competitions, allowing our junior associations to compete against each other regularly.

The Sydney Cup competition is a highly competitive event that Baseball NSW runs as a mandatory pathway through to the Little League programs. This year, the prestigious event will showcase players from across Sydney.



This is a representative-selected tournament. Associations can enter one team with 14 of their best players into the Sydney Cup. This year, Baseball NSW has reformatted the competition in accordance with the team numbers provided across all associations.

Baseball NSW State Development Officer, Coen Wynne, will be the designated contact for the Sydney Cup. The schedule for this year's competition is being finalised and will be released as soon as possible.


