

NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE – EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

In accordance with the Constitutional amendments ratified by voting members at the 2022 Annual General Meeting, the Board of Baseball NSW are seeking Expressions of Interest from our current membership to be considered for the proposed Nominations Committee.

The Nominations Committee has a role in the appointment process for Baseball NSW Directors. Candidates seeking to become a Director of Baseball NSW will first be screened by the Nominations Committee to ensure that they meet the eligibility requirements for election.

The Nominations Committee seeks to ensure that candidates are not disqualified under relevant laws, have an established record of, or are deemed capable of making a sound contribution to the operations of boards and committees, and are of good standing.

Successful candidates will be considered and elected by the current Baseball NSW Board of Directors.

The composition of the Nominations Committee shall be as follows:

- i. An independent chair who shall be appointed by the Board;
- ii. A Director chosen by the Board; and
- iii. A representative nominated by the Voting Members.
