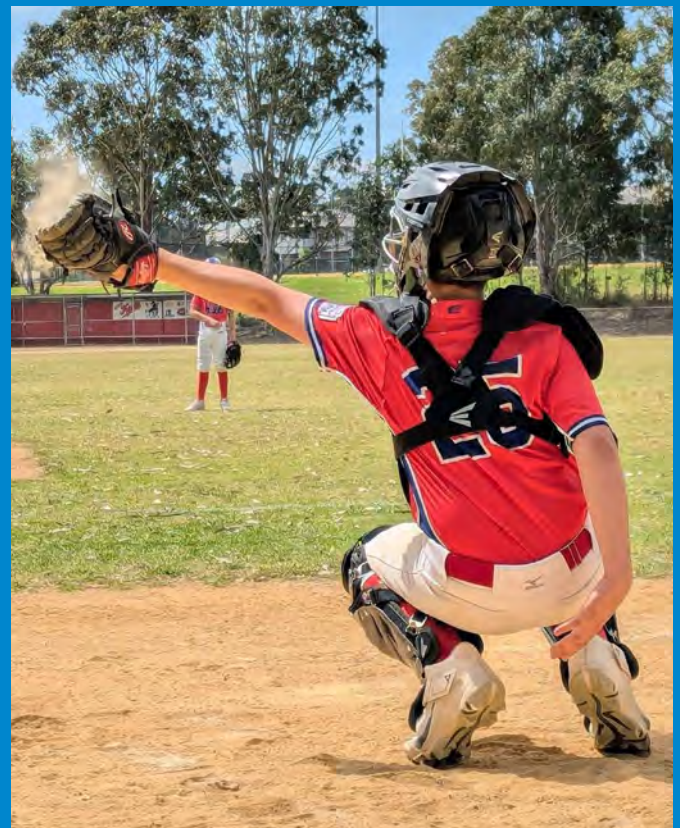

DEVELOPING AND PERFORMANCE PATHWAY PROGRAM

These two programs are the dedicated Winter Development programs for those players age eligible for AYC selection, giving them the option to participate in high performance activities over the off season.

This year, the Performance Pathway program was comprised of 27 players selected from a trial process in May. This was an U/18 squad that trained three times a week for 10 weeks (June to August) at BISP.

The Development Pathway program was comprised of 32 of the best U/16 age eligible players selected after a trial process in May. These players trained twice a week for 10 weeks (June to August) at BISP also.

The emphasis for these programs is on building up the players' strength, running speed, arm and bat velocity as well as game awareness.

Both programs used development tools such as Driveline, BLAST motion bat sensors, RAPSODO ball flight technology, Speed Development/Mobility, and Strength & Conditioning programs.

U18 Junior National Tour Team and Schedule Announced

Australia's U18 National Squad is off to the United States at the start of next month to compete in prestigious baseball tournaments in front of professional scouts and college recruiters.

42 Aussie players will play in tournaments against the best American prospects through the Perfect Game World Wood Bat Championships.

The event is widely considered the top scouting attraction in all of amateur baseball each year, and almost every top prospect in the USA attends, along with 700+ MLB scouts and college coaches.



The U18 National Squad has teams entered in two different tournaments, both in Florida:

- The 'Fort Myers Team' U18 National Squad will play in the PG World Wood Bat Association Underclass World Championships (October 3-7)

– The **'Jupiter'** U18 National Squad will play in the PG World Wood Bat Association World Championships (October 10-14)

The difference between 'Underclass' and not is underclass is against players typically in Year 11 in the United States. The Jupiter tournament will be played against players in Year 12.

Baseball Australia's player development manager Andrew Riddell says he's looking forward to getting both teams to the U.S and playing against the best players in their age groups

"In a non-U18 World Cup year, this is the best event that any Year 11 or Year 12 player will get a chance to participate in," he says. "They will both have busy schedules from when they land until when the tournament starts with practice sessions, games against junior colleges/ universities and also a special international exhibition showcase that will be announced shortly."
