- ❑ John played all his junior baseball with Condell Park Baseball Club 1985-1995.
- ❑ John was a member of the 1994/95 Australian Team that went to Brazil.
- ❑ Selected to the Australian National Team 2001 played in Taiwan and awarded MVP for the series.
- ❑ Member of the Australian Olympic team winning the Silver Medal at the 2004 Athens Olympics.
- ❑ Selected to the Australian National team 2005.
- ❑ Selected to the 2006 Australian World Baseball Classic Team.
- ❑ Pitcher for several years with the Australian National Team.
- ❑ Professional career: Signed by Baltimore Orioles as an amateur free agent July 1996. Orioles honoured John with the Jim Palmer Prize (an award given annually to the best pitcher in Baltimore's farm system). John was more dominant in 2001, playing for the Bowie Baysox, he was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Year, and player of the month, he also made the League's All-Star team. At the end of the season John was awarded the Jim Palmer Prize for the second time. Selected off waiver by Boston Redsox from the Orioles in April 2004, released by Boston April 2005.
- ❑ Signed as a free agent with the Chicago White Sox, released by Chicago June 2005. Signed as a free agent with Baltimore Orioles July 2005, released by the Orioles June 2006, signed as a free agent with the Philadelphia Phillies July 2006 and granted free agency in October 2006.
- ❑ Inducted into the 2013 Bankstown Municipality Sporting Hall of Fame.
- ❑ Inducted into the Baseball Australia Hall of Fame as a Player in 2017 for the Era 2000+.
- ❑ Inducted into the Baseball NSW Hall of Fame 2025.
