2026/27 Capitation Fees

Baseball NSW is pleased to confirm the 2026/27 capitation fee schedule for affiliated clubs and registered members.

The 2026/27 capitation fees reflect a modest adjustment respectively across League Age categories, as outlined in the fee schedule.

Capitation fees remain the primary mechanism through which Baseball NSW supports the delivery of programs, services and development initiatives across the state, enabling continued investment in participation growth, coach and official development, competition delivery and support for clubs at all levels of the game.

- Total Capitation shown in the attached are inclusive of the 3.85% transaction fee charged by GameDay.
- Baseball Australia will invoice clubs the 2% transaction fee charged by GameDay for Active Kids vouchers processed. This will be invoiced directly to the club that receives the voucher funds.
